# **Excel** Pathway

To compete in this event schools must qualify through their level 2 competitions in their boroughs.

### **Teams**

All players must be in year 3 and/or year 4 Squads have 10 players, 5 girls and 5 boys

### Equipment

Tri-Golf equipment bag (right/left handed irons and putters, balls, game and team cards)
Extra cones
2m Velcro target
Stopwatch and whistle

## **Competition Format**

Teams will complete a 10 station Tri-Golf cluster festival comprising eight skill activities and two non-scoring bunker rest stops.

Each team will accumulate a score for each game and a total score for the festival. With the highest score winning.

Each team will be split into two groups of five. At each station there will be two groups of five.

There will be a two minute practice time and five minutes of scoring per game.

# Intra-school Inter-school County level

### **Scoring**

Tri-Golf competitions allow children to compete individually and as part of a team. One person in each team is responsible for reading instructions and keeping score on scorecard. The scoring is explained on each card.

### Fair Play

The ideals of good sportsmanship and respect should permeate throughout all competitive and recreational sport. They are displayed by someone who abides by the rules of a contest, respects their opponents and accepts victory or defeat graciously.

# **Health and Safety**

Players must be in suitable footwear.

No jewellery to be worn.

All loose clothing must be tucked in and shoelaces tied.

No chewing gum or sweets.

Medical supplies that players may need should be brought with them on the day i.e. asthma inhalers.

All team teachers must ensure their pupils are under adult supervision at all times, even when playing.
